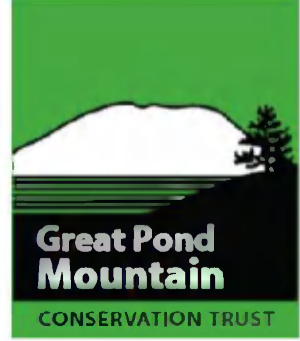

## WILDLANDS REGULATIONS

- Dogs are welcome **ON LEASH**. No dogs on Hothole Brook or Great Meadow trails. Porcupines are common!
- **PATHS** are for foot traffic only. **TRAILS** welcome horses and bicycles. Snowmobile on designated trails. See map at [www.familysnowmobileclub.com](http://www.familysnowmobileclub.com). Trail use is at your own risk.
- ATVs, dirt bikes, off-road vehicles and drones prohibited.
- Hunters please contact GPMCT to register; hunting policy at [www.greatpondtrust.org](http://www.greatpondtrust.org).
- Camping and fires by permission only; contact us to camp at Baker Brook (lean-to and tent sites) or Mitchville (tent site). Reservation form and guidelines at [www.greatpondtrust.org](http://www.greatpondtrust.org).
- Collecting live plants or animals is prohibited.

## ACCESS INFORMATION

**Hothole Valley South Gate**, Rte. 1 near Rte. 176 intersection in East Orland, will be open to autos 8 am to dusk (check posted closing times at gate) weekends mid-June through Oct. and some Fridays. Weekend visitors may park in the inner lot at the Valley Road/Hothole Brook Trail junction or off the road at trailheads. Please do not block barricades. Horse trailer parking at meadow about 1.3 mi. from South Gate on left, or park along one side of Valley Road. Weekday visitors use gate parking lot.

**Hothole Valley North Gate**, Bald Mtn. Road in North Orland, 0.2 mi. west of Winkumpaugh Rd., will remain locked; parking available.

**Dead River Gate**, Don Fish Rd. 0.5 mi. past Craig Brook National Fish Hatchery in East Orland, will remain locked; parking available at gate. Horse trailers park at Hatchery.

**Great Pond Mountain, Stuart Gross Trail**, Don Fish Rd., 1 mile past Craig Brook National Fish Hatchery. Parking available. Bikes and horses please use the Dead River Gate & Connector Trail.
