

# Hunting/Trapping Policy 2018

## Great Pond Mountain Wildlands

### Hunting

- Hunting is allowed, subject to State laws. Hunters must register with GPMCT before the season starts and familiarize themselves with our hunting policy. Call Steward, 469-6929 or e-mail [info@greatpondtrust.org](mailto:info@greatpondtrust.org) to register.
- No baiting of any animal (except for trapping purposes, as allowable by State laws)
- No permanent tree stands or duck blinds
- No hunting within 100 feet of maintained gravel roads or parking lots
- No ATV or 4WD access – walk in only. A game hauler is available at the GPMCT office – call 469-6929 to borrow. Assistance will also be available from Wildlands Ranger in removing deer only from the Wildlands
- Hunters are requested to report their harvest to GPMCT via annual survey
- Hunters asked to pick up litter, report any trash dumps, and report any game violations they witness to GPMCT or local game wardens

### Fishing

Fishing is allowed Wildlands, subject to State laws.

### Trapping

- Trapping is allowed, subject to State laws. By State law, all trappers must have written permission from GPMCT before trapping and carry permission with them.
- Call Steward at 469-6929 or e-mail [info@greatpondtrust.org](mailto:info@greatpondtrust.org) to register
- No trapping within 100 ft. of any roads, woods roads, hiking trails or parking lots
- Trappers are asked to submit a brief annual trapping report to GPMCT, outlining their harvest and their observations
- No ATV or 4WD access – walk-in only
- No live trapping of any animal without prior consultation with GPMCT
