Policy on Unmanned Aerial Vehicles and Drones

GPMCT prohibits the use of unmanned aerial vehicles, drones, radio-controlled model airplanes and/ or any other equipment of this type on or above its property unless approved by GPMCT in writing in advance. This policy supports our commitment to the protection of wildlife and the safety and well-being of our visitors. This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, any and all use of drones for purposes of aerial photography, videography and entertainment or recreational use. GPMCT may approve applications for the operation of unmanned aerial systems for purposes such as search and rescue, scientific research, mapping, authorized photo/film shoots, or Land Trust projects. Applications will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. If approved, GPMCT will issue a limited permit for the use of unmanned aerial systems for the specific project and a limited time period.
